# V

- 1- During all synchronous sessions, keep your video switched on and sit in a quiet environment away from all distractions.
- 2- Wear appropriate attire as stated by the school, with a clear background. ( No caps, No Sleep wear).
- 3- Use Official name ( As in ISAMS AND MANAGEBAC) in the Zoom and Google meet Profile and in the Device.
- 4- Always reply or acknowledge receipt when reading teachers' announcements. ( Use Reaction emojis)
- 5- Participate in class discussion and conversation during Synchronous sessions. Always communicate through discussion or via chat. In asynchronous mode via Google classroom.
- 6- Regularly appear in all lessons and Homeroom sessions.
- 7- Make good use of the teacher's office hours and Homeroom time to clear out any confusion or misunderstanding during the lesson.

- 1- Join classes on time (Eg : 8.30 am for Homeroom and 9 am for Lesson 1 ) and be prepared with all the materials needed.
2. Always ready with appropriate device and Internet connection. (Communicate to Parents and School ahead of time if there is an issue)
- 3- Read lesson objectives and prepare for the lesson on the previous night.
- 4- Set up a personal schedule that will help note down and keep track of upcoming assignments and tasks according to the deadline. ( seek help with the Homeroom Teacher if needed).
- 5- Check Managebac and google classroom regularly for posted assignments or feedback from the teachers.
- 6- Make sure to submit assignments by the deadline and in the right location according to the teacher's instruction.
- 7- Organize folders on the tablet or computer to locate easily when needed. (Seek help is there in a need)
- 8- Always respect deadlines and keep up to date with all assignments.

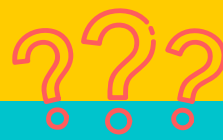
## CARING

- 4- Respond to teachers via Google Classroom.

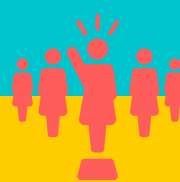
## ANALYTICAL



# A

- 1- Identify and think ahead of possible solutions for potential problems or challenges and communicate to the Parents/ Teachers/ Coordinators.
- 2- Set objectives for what needs to be achieved in the week/ month/ semester/ academic year and prepare a plan that will help to keep track and monitor progress.
- 3- Read the instructions, go through the tutorials, and assign reading materials in google classroom to build an understanding of the material before starting your task or assignment.
- 4- Once a formative or summative assessment is marked, revise the sections that you did not perform well and work towards understanding the mistakes.
- 5- Ask the teacher for feedback on your progress in class and make adjustments where needed to continually improve your skills and understanding of the subject.
